Museum & Animal Park (Fee Required)
Access the Sacramento River and walk areas outside the museum for free.

Visit anytime to view historic buildings and ruins from the gold rush or visit the Courthouse Museum Thur-Sun 10am-5pm.

Shasta Caverns (Fee Required)

North of Redding but worth it if you have a free day. Huge cave system tour requiring a boat ride across Shasta Lake (watch for eagles) and a bus up to the cave entrance. Call for winter hours or to book a group tour and bring a jacket.
